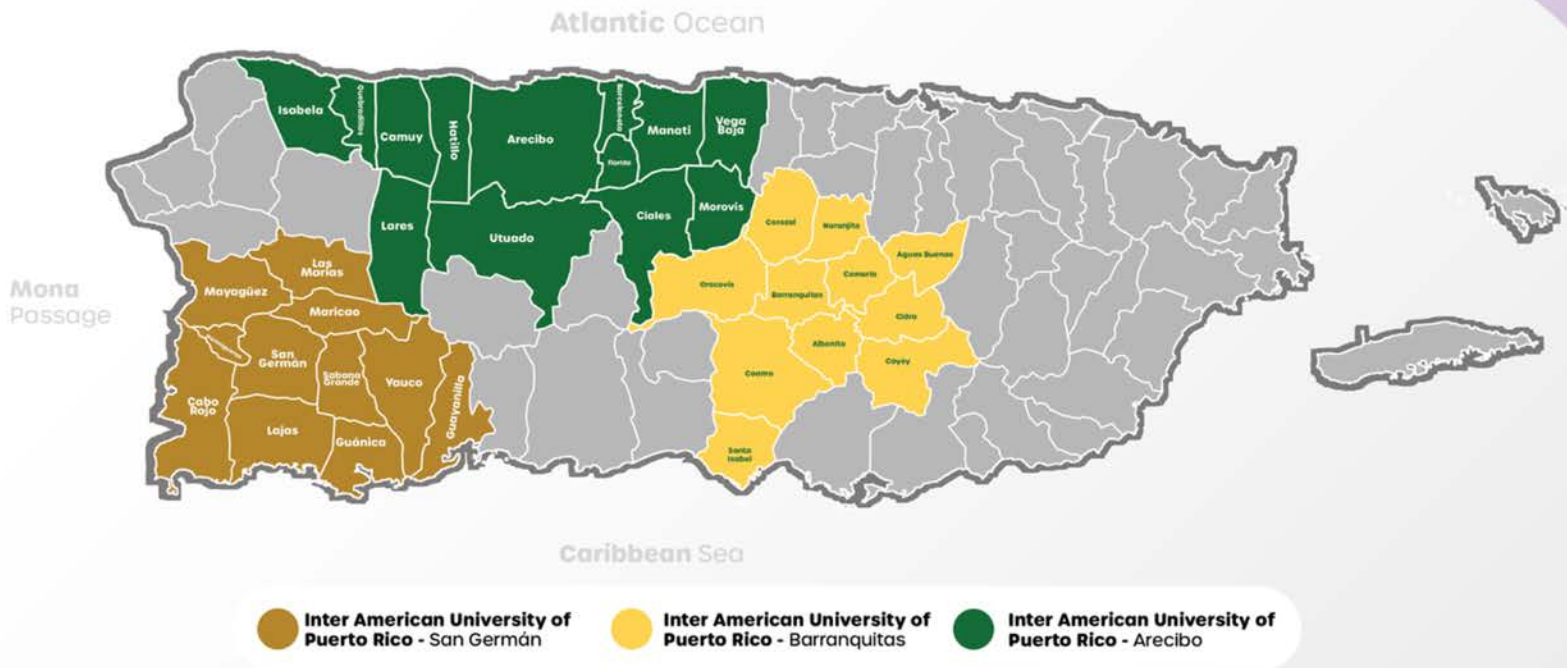

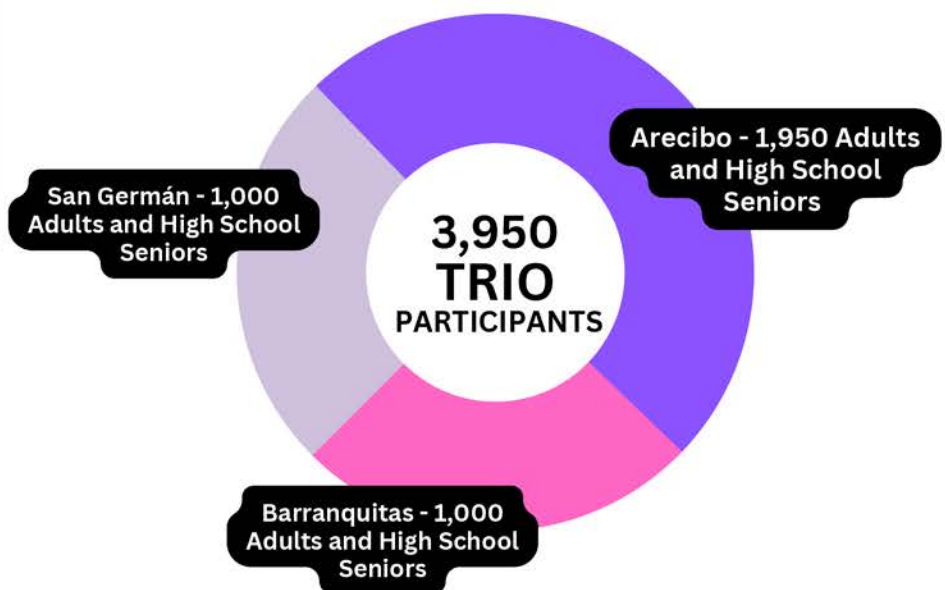

Serve **3,950** Seniors and Adults through **3** projects which provide services to participants in **34** counties across the Island.



Our participants typically come from low-income households where no one has previously completed a college degree. We are proud to serve each student and adults. With continued funding for our programs, we are eager to serve many more!



EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY CENTERS

Educational Opportunity Centers (EOC), serving adults, provide counseling and information on college admissions to qualified adults who want to enter or continue a program of postsecondary education. The program also provides services to improve the financial and economic literacy of participants. An important objective of the program is to counsel participants on financial aid options, including basic financial planning skills, and to assist in the college application process. The goal of EOC is to increase the number of adult participants who enroll in postsecondary education institutions.

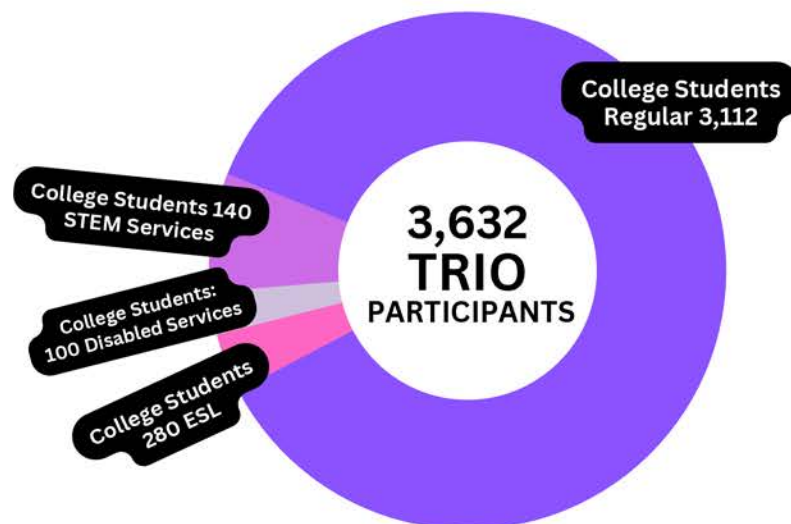

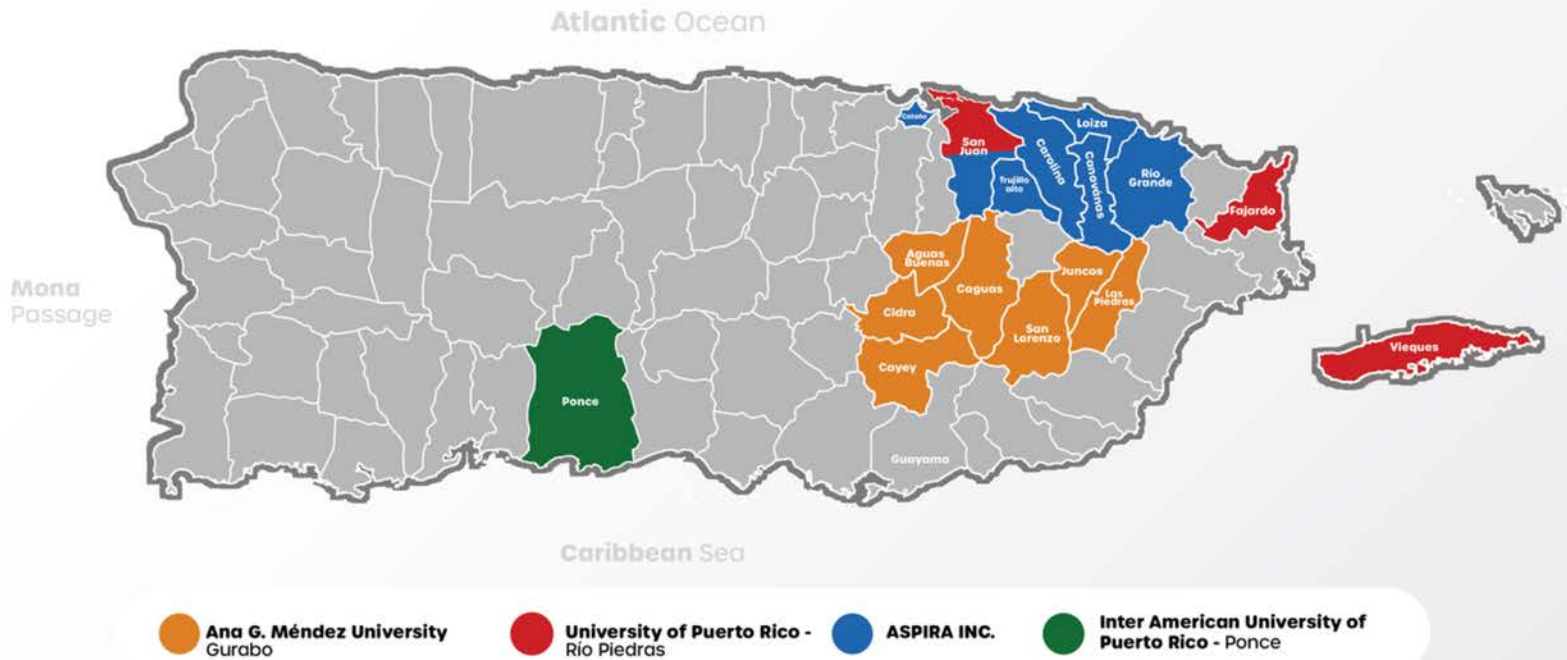

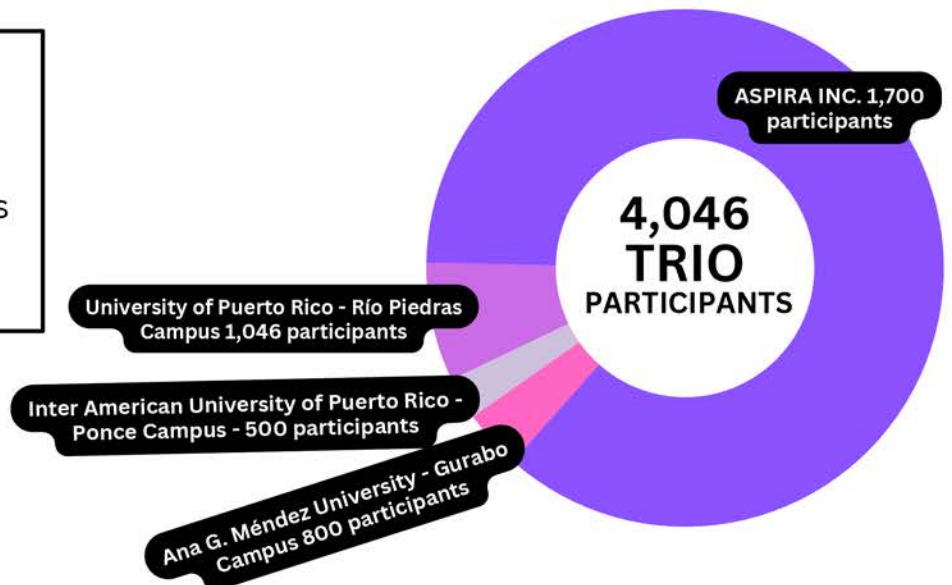
STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Talent Search



Serve **4,046** 6th to 12th grade students as well as adult high school dropouts through **4** projects which provide services to participants in **17** counties across the Island.

We need continued funding to provide educational opportunities to our participants from an early stage.

Talent Search also encourages persons who have not completed education programs at the secondary or postsecondary level to enter or reenter and complete postsecondary education. The goal of Talent Search is to increase the number of youths from disadvantaged backgrounds to complete high school and enroll in and complete their postsecondary education.

MCNAIR PROGRAMS

Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Programs (McNair), serving college students interested in Ph.D. studies, prepare eligible participants for doctoral studies through involvement in research and other scholarly activities. Participants are from disadvantaged backgrounds and have demonstrated strong academic potential. Grantees work closely with participants as they complete their undergraduate requirements, encouraging participants to enroll in graduate programs and then track their progress to the successful completion of advanced degrees. The goal is to increase the attainment of Ph.D. degrees by students from underrepresented segments of society.

UPWARD BOUND REGULAR & MATH & SCIENCE

Upward Bound (UB) Regular and Math & Science (UBMS) provides fundamental support to participants in their preparation for college entrance. The program offers opportunities for participants to succeed in their precollege performance and ultimately in their higher education pursuits. Upward Bound serves high school students from low-income families and from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree. The goal of Upward Bound is to increase the rate at which participants complete secondary education and enroll in and graduate from institutions of postsecondary education by providing the skills and motivation to do so. UBMS is designed to strengthen the math and science skills of participating students.

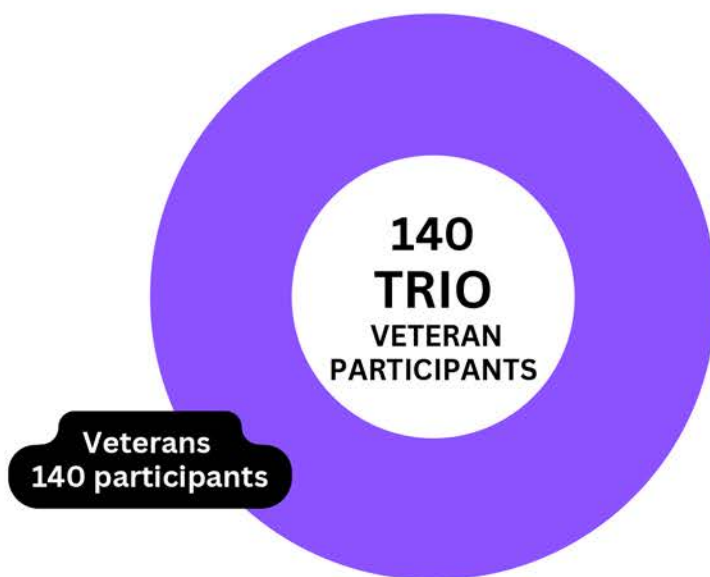

Veterans Upward Bound (VUB), serving veterans, provides assessment and enhancement of basic skills through counseling, mentoring, tutoring, and academic instruction in the core subject areas. The primary goal of the program is to increase the rate at which participants enroll in and complete postsecondary education programs.

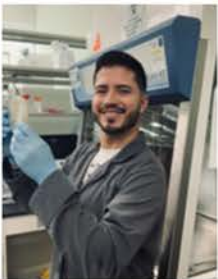
